Santa Bárbara Castle

→ Standing 166m above sea level, this is one of the largest medieval fortresses in Spain, and one which had great strategic value in the Medieval Period. The castle remained abandoned until 1963, when it was opened to the public. Don't miss the highest tower, "La Torreta," from where you can overlook the whole bay.
